## LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING MINUTES

January 7, 2020 Courthouse Commissioner Room Ivanhoe, MN 56142

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Board Chair Mic VanDeVere, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioners present were Joe Drietz, Mic VanDeVere and Jack Vizecky. Commissioner Sik and Hamer were absent. Also present was Lincoln County Auditor, Deb Vierhuf. No conflicts of interest were noted.

Chad Meester, Lincoln County Sheriff, presented the employee evaluation/review form for the Sheriff's office. Motion was tabled until next meeting.

Meester requested approval to join the Buffalo Ridge Task Force. Commissioner VanDeVere stated that he thought the department should have all open positions filled before we make that decision. More information will be brought forward later in the year. Information only.

Meester informed the Board that there was a major repair on one of the squad vehicles. Information only.

Commissioner VanDeVere informed the Board that we need to appoint someone to the SWHHS Committee. Joan Jagt has been contacted and is interested in being a member. Motion by VanDeVere, seconded by Drietz to appoint Joan Jagt to the SWHHS Board. Commissioner Drietz and VanDeVere voted in favor. Commissioner Vizecky voted in opposition. Motion carried by majority vote.

Joe Wilson, Lincoln County Engineer, was present to give project updates. They were as follows:

- Continuing to work on bridge replacement plans and ADA sidewalk plans for Hendricks, Ivanhoe, Lake Benton and Tyler.
- Working on acquiring the right-of-way for the Hwy 7 widening project.

Wilson presented maintenance updates. They were as follows:

- Snow and ice removal
- Equipment repairs.
- The Ivanhoe grader needed to go back for repairs that will be covered under warranty.
- Will do equipment and shop maintenance as time permits.
- Will be putting some numbers together for 2020 equipment replacement.
- The city of Tyler has requested a letter of commitment from the County for the Safe Routes to School Boost Grant. Dustin Hauschild, Lincoln County Engineer's Assistant has been attending the informational meetings to get updates on this grant project.

Amber Scholten, Lincoln County Emergency Management, requested approval of the 2020 Safe Assure contract. The cost for the 2020 contract is \$5,764.86. Motion by VanDeVere, seconded by Vizecky to approve the 2020 Safe Assure Contract in the amount of \$5,764.86. All (3) voted in favor.

Robert Olsen, Lincoln County Environmental, gave a report on the 2019 land use and septic permits. Information only.

Olsen requested approval of the 2020 AIS Plan. The total amount to be received once the plan is submitted is \$64,030.00. Motion by VanDeVere, seconded by Vizecky to approve the 2020 AIS Plan. All (3) voted in favor.

Olsen informed the Board that he feels the radio ads have been beneficial in getting the word out about how to avoid spreading weeds from lake to lake. The county will need to do another treatment on Lake Benton Lake this year if the DNR will approve a second treatment. Information only.

Robert Olsen, Lincoln County Environmental, informed the Board that two individuals need to be reappointed to the Planning and Zoning Board. The individuals for appointment are Ron Bunjer, and Wendy Schalek. Olsen stated that both individuals are in favor of being re-appointed and they have been doing a good job. We will need to find someone to fill the City of Tyler spot. Motion by Vizecky, seconded by VanDeVere to approve the following appointments to the Planning and Zoning Board:

Ron Bunjer – District 5 Representative - 3 Year term Wendy Schalek – District 3 Representative – 3 year term All (3) voted in favor.

Olsen informed the Board that he would like to start the process for adding on additional cold storage to the maintenance garage. This additional storage would be used to house the Environmental vehicles. Olsen would like to use the capital improvement funds and pay back over time. The Board would like Olsen to check to see if the highway department is in need of any storage. The Board was in consensus with moving forward with applying for a building permit from the city. Information only.

Commissioner VanDeVere and Vizecky voted in favor. Commissioner Drietz abstained due to a bill for Ivanhoe Service Center. Motion carried by majority vote.

The following bills were over \$2,000.00 per M.S. 375.12: A & C Excavating LLC - \$6,345.00, Ground Works, LLC - \$4,278.45, Kirkvold Oil Co. - \$2,641.38, Lyon Co Auditor-Treasurer - \$17,312.35, MN Counties Intergovernmental Trust – St. Paul - \$141,197.00, Sterzinger Construction - \$2,531.03, SW Regional Development Commission - \$6,097.50 and 31 payments less than \$2,000.00 - \$11,435.95.

Deb Vierhuf, Lincoln County Auditor-Treasurer, presented the Sheriff's AFSCME Memorandum of Understanding regarding having an administrative bank for payroll hours to allow for a 21 or 28 day rotating schedule. Discussion was held and the MOU was tabled until next meeting. Information only.

Vierhuf informed the Board that the new IRS mileage rate for 2020 is \$.57. Information only.
